Planting



4 rows of planting, 12.5-16.5 cm. spacing between plants, 24-32 per square meter.

Pinching



- Pinch at about 5-7 cm. high, leaving 3-5 pairs of leaves.
- The picture demonstrates the first pruning in growing "singles" (without pinch). Pinch is performed in a similar manner.

Pinching



- Pinching in mother plants, for example, is carried out above 2 pairs of leaves
- In a commercial area pinch above 3-5 pairs of leaves, as recommended

The vegetative stage– Short day

This stage is intended to allow the stems to reach the desired length

Short day prevents induction to flower early. Hence, it is recommended to plant either in summer or autumn when day is relatively short

Switching to long-day treatment

Begin when plants are 30-40 cm tall



The generative stage– Long day



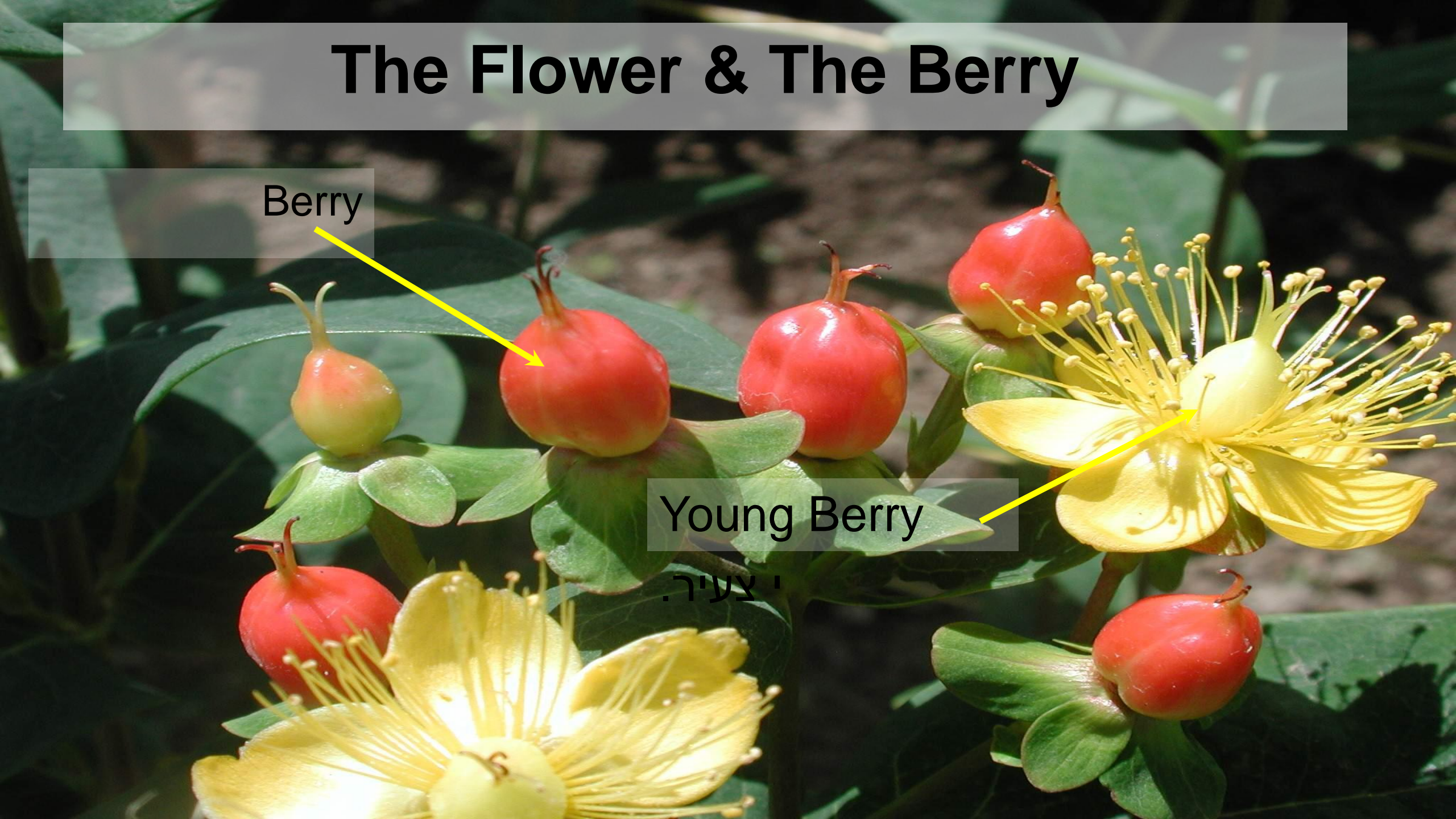
In summer daylight is prolonged to 18 hours
In winter lighting is applied all night

Harvest

Harvest is carried out when about 80% of the berries on the branch are ripe and almost all the flowers have dropped

Harvest

Sorting by length, 70-80 cm.

Remove all leaves from 1/3 of the lower part of the branch.
